

Cockatoo Island has an ‘in-tents’ New Year’s Eve experience for you!

If you’re looking for a New Year’s Eve experience, away from the crowds and close to the action, glamping and camping at Cockatoo Island is just the ticket. Create memories under the Sydney Harbour fireworks, surrounded by live music, plenty of entertainment for all ages and the most unique accommodation a New Year’s Eve party can ask for.

Glamping and camping packages for Cockatoo Island’s New Year’s Eve extravaganza are on sale 9am, Monday 18 June and are inclusive of all entertainment for the little (and big) kids. If New Year’s Eve means a little luxury in the heart of Sydney Harbour, a glamping stay-cation provides all the possibilities without the fuss. Packages offer complete sleeping amenities and cater for two to six people, starting from \$950 for a two night stay. Camping packages are also available and include tent, sleeping mats and chairs. One and two night stays start from \$800, tents sleeping four to six people.

Cockatoo Island also provides space for those who already have all the gear and are simply searching for the hassle free views. Bring-your-own camping sites are available at various locations across the island and start from \$450, for a one night.

Once the family is settled in one of Cockatoo Island’s premium camp set-ups, release the kids for a wild adventure around Sydney’s largest island. Over two massive days, 30 and 31 December, morning until night entertainment will keep even the pickiest of the crew happy. A kid’s scooter track will take pride of place inside the Industrial Precinct while movie marathons will run in the Wolverine cinema. Tours and talks are also included entertainment.

To cap off the two-day funfest, the countdown to 2019 will be accompanied by live music and sweet countdown tunes. Guests can enjoy Sydney’s impressive firework show as they explode meters from the shoreline.
